Washington CARES Act Grants:

- **These Grants are REIMBURSIBLE and cover LOST REVENUE.**
- **The Application must be filled out COMPLETELY.**
- **Grants are available to both Small Businesses AND Nonprofits.**
- **There will be a list of expenses that are approved and not approved.**

Grant County Commissioners have allocated \$2.5 million of their CARES Act funds to present to small businesses and nonprofit organizations within Grant County. These dollars can be used for loss of revenue and are intended to help small businesses and nonprofits during this unprecedented and difficult time. A small business or nonprofit for this instance is defined as a business with **20** or less Full-Time Employees.

The Grant County Economic Development Council is helping facilitate CARES Act reimbursable grants with the Grant County Commissioners. Reimbursable grants are grants that are paid out after expenses are completed. You will complete an application for the grant, and if approved and selected you will then be asked to submit receipts for the eligible funds for reimbursement. Loss of revenue will be included in the reimbursable grant. There will be a list of expenses that are approved as well as a list of expenses that are **not** eligible for grant funding (**including payroll**).

Please remember to fill out the application for these grants **completely**. Any application that is not completely filled out will not be accepted and you will be asked to resubmit.

We plan to go through these grants in phases, so if you do not get in the first phase, please remember that there will soon be other phases.

Applications for these grants will be made available on our website at grantedc.com/grants starting on Wednesday, July 22nd at 3:00 p.m.

The first round for these applications will be due by Friday, July 31st by 5:00 p.m.
